The Institute provides facilities for experienced teachers, administrators and others who would like to engage in research without registering for a higher degree or diploma. You will normally register as a special research student. The length of your programme will be arranged between yourself and the Institute and may last for one or two terms or a full academic year. You may either be attached to a faculty, or you may carry out individual studies under the guidance of a tutor.

Fees for special research programmes are determined on a pro rata basis.
